The ceremony concluded with the distribution of prasad, leaving everyone with a sense of peace and rejuvenation.











Science Debate:

August 01, 2024 - Grades XI & XII








August 3, 2024 - Grades I to III




The IT department organized an engaging and challenging activity, "Techno Puzzle," for students of Classes I to III on August 3, 2024.

Reading Fun With Phonic Sounds


August 03, 2024 - Grades Nursery to LKG

Celebrating the Wisdom of Sanskrit: Sukti Lekhan Activity




August 6, 2024 - Grades VI to VIII



Bhardwaj and Dr. Rubina.







August 14, 2024 - Grades Nursery to UKG




The Tiranga Parade was one of the most memorable parts of the event, with students proudly marching around the school campus carrying the national flag.






Debug the Code Activity:


A Showcase of Problem-Solving Skills August 20, 2024 - Grades XI & XII



Samarpan A Reverent Celebration of Founder's Day August 28, 2024





The program was well-received, offering valuable insights into the need for self-care in today's fast-paced world.




Class VII D Theme: "CULTURAL HERITAGE OF INDIA"


